Jeki Yoo, a magician celebrated for his unique ideas in magic, blends artistry with innovation to deliver performances that are both practical and effective. With over 20 years of professional stage experience, he is not only a master of sleight of hand and quick-change artistry but also a visionary in modern magic.

**J-shirt**: This original colour-changing T-shirt effect by Jeki Yoo is incredibly visual and clever, designed to elevate any opening show. It's a unique routine that audiences have never seen before.

**Poker-X**: Jeki Yoo's new visual matrix routine uses four blank cards and four poker chips. The routine features entertaining techniques and mechanisms that allow for magic to happen even in the spectator's hands. It received acclaim at the FISM European Championship.

**Coaster Monte:** In this latest creation, Jeki Yoo gives a modern, magical twist to the classic street scam, Disk Monte. Using everyday coasters, the routine is ideal for bars and close-up performances. Three coasters-two with blue poker chips at the centre and one with a red chip-are shuffled and the spectator attempts to locate the red one but ultimately fails. For the climax, a poker chip placed on a coaster magically smiles, leaving the audience astonished.

**4 Dimension**: Inspired by Jerry Andrus Mylar Mystery:" this routine has been one of Jeki's favourite openers since 2007. Loved by audiences on TV, at conventions, and on stages worldwide, it features a mylar

sheet with a red circle that transforms into a solid ball, then returns to the sheet as a drawing.

**Cone and Ball:** This routine is Jeki Yoo's modern take on the classic cone and ball, inspired by Dai Vernon and Aldo Colombini. It strikes a perfect balance between simplicity and modern flair, with a clear structure that is easy for any audience to follow.

**Impromptu Haunted**: This haunted deck routine by Jeki requires nothing but a regular deck of cards--no crumpling or setup necessary. It can even be performed with a borrowed deck. The routine is full of surprises and became a bestseller on Penguin Magic under the name "Fright".
